For the best results, buy products in a limited colour palette – two to three hues. We used red and black to impart a manly feel. Brown and black or black and grey would work too.

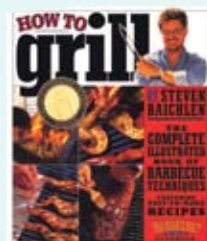
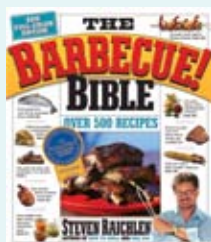
