How to style a harvest table

- 1.** Start with an elegant and timeless base – a tan linen tablecloth and rustic cream dinnerware. These neutral pieces can be tailored to a variety of milieus with linens and accessories.
- 2.** Add punches of colour with a combination of linens in a rich, contemporary palette for fall: plum, gold and ivory with touches of chartreuse, brown, orange and fuchsia.
- 3.** Complete the setting – and stimulate multiple sales – by gathering a mixture of items consumers will need for their Thanksgiving tables.

The Unexpected

A prop or product used in an unexpected way adds an air of quirkiness to a display. On top of the table, this chair creates a contrast of heights which captures the interest of passersby. On a practical level, it acts as a riser and maximizes the selling space by providing another platform for showcasing products.



Dress in Layers

Create visual layers of interest in tabletop displays by overlapping linens. Showing a range of complementary linens also helps increase your add-on sales.

Hang Ups

Hanging related items (such as plates, platters and serving trays) on the wall extends the display space, allows you to add another layer of product to the setting and makes the display richer and more lifelike.
